Patients and other CardHolders (CareGivers and Growers responsible for them) need medicine (cannabis) immediately upon successful registration with the OMMP and can't wait for the grow cycle. There is no Dispensary system and the only legal means is to find available excess medicine. Under Oregon law CardHolders are allowed to exchange medicine and related – plants, “medibles” (prepared food items containing medicine) – for No Consideration.

Further, CardHolders also need related Resources – lights, and other Medical Cannabis specific Grow resources – as well as “bongs”, vaporizers and other Medical Cannabis Delivery Devices – and, some cases more importantly, relevant Information they can't get anywhere else.

Finding Places for Meetings, usually Private, and Meet-Ups, usually Public, and Enabling and Organizing same. These are for the purposes of –

-allowing OMMP card-holders to

from OutReach and Resource Networking to find Places for all purposes, but especially Indoor with wheel-chair accessible bathrooms for the Medical Cannabis Community to use, if just to match up Patients and Growers, et al.

Noted MERCY shares office space with Mercy Center LLC, Perry Stripling relationship with both entities.

Noted occupancy expense. Pls provide copy of lease / rental agreement. Pls provide documentation on how FMV was determined for organizations portion of this expense.

Initially, in the first year, value of relationship determined by rent and other expenses paid by LLC. Paid part of rent and phone / DSL for Office. LLC also uses NON space to Store and Show product on a limited basis. Subsequent to first year of NON-profit operations FMV will be portion of office space and those phone calls directly related to LLC.

Example, LLC uses half of 10' x 10' office and 2' x 3' space in main area. This is determined to be 56 square feet out of 1258 total or .04 percent. That times rent (1550) is \$62, and that, plus any phone usage related to the LLC, will be the FMV for the month.

Relationship; for the purposes of making contacts and building business relationships. For MERCY Gift Shop, separate Store, Shows and beyond. One function of the LLC is to network items to the medical cannabis community that MERCY the non-profit can not, for one reason or another.

What is Mercy Center LLC business purposes.

The LLC is to sell items and places that the NON-profit can't. Currently the LLC will sell novelties, educational, informational and promotional items about MERCY and the Issue in general. Future items may include entertainment and event oriented items and activities. There is discussion of including Hemp goods in the catalog.
