- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "ORS" delete the rest of the
- 2 line and insert "475.302 and 475.340.".
- 3 Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert:
- 4 "SECTION 1. ORS 475.302 is amended to read:
- 5 "475.302. As used in ORS 475.300 to 475.346;
- 6 "(1) 'Attending physician' means a physician licensed under ORS chapter
- 7 677 who has primary responsibility for the care and treatment of a person
- 8 diagnosed with a debilitating medical condition.
- 9 "(2) 'Debilitating medical condition' means:
- "(a) Cancer, glaucoma, positive status for human immunodeficiency virus
- or acquired immune deficiency syndrome, or treatment for these conditions;
- "(b) A medical condition or treatment for a medical condition that
- 13 produces, for a specific patient, one or more of the following:
- 14 "(A) Cachexia;
- "(B) Severe pain;
- "(C) Severe nausea;
- 17 "(D) Seizures, including but not limited to seizures caused by epilepsy;
- 18 or
- "(E) Persistent muscle spasms, including but not limited to spasms caused
- 20 by multiple sclerosis; or
- 21 "(c) Any other medical condition or treatment for a medical condition
- 22 adopted by the department by rule or approved by the department pursuant
- 23 to a petition submitted pursuant to ORS 475.334.
- "(3) 'Delivery' has the meaning given that term in ORS 475.005.

- "(4) 'Department' means the Department of Human Services.
- "(5) 'Designated primary caregiver' means an individual 18 years of age
- 3 or older who has significant responsibility for managing the well-being of a
- 4 person who has been diagnosed with a debilitating medical condition and
- 5 who is designated as such on that person's application for a registry iden-
- 6 tification card or in other written notification to the department. 'Designated
- 7 primary caregiver' does not include the person's attending physician.
- 8 "(6) 'Marijuana' has the meaning given that term in ORS 475.005.
- 9 "(7) 'Medical use of marijuana' means the production, possession, deliv-
- 10 ery, or administration of marijuana, including having evidence of
- 11 marijuana in the person's system, or paraphernalia used to administer
- marijuana, as necessary for the exclusive benefit of a person to mitigate the
- 13 symptoms or effects of [his or her] the person's debilitating medical condi-
- 14 tion.
- "(8) 'Production' has the same meaning given that term in ORS 475.005.
- 16 "(9) 'Registry identification card' means a document issued by the de-
- 17 partment that identifies a person authorized to engage in the medical use
- 18 of marijuana and the person's designated primary caregiver, if any.
- "(10) 'Usable marijuana' means the dried leaves and flowers of the plant
- 20 Cannabis family Moraceae, and any mixture or preparation thereof, that are
- 21 appropriate for medical use as allowed in ORS 475.300 to 475.346. 'Usable
- 22 marijuana' does not include the seeds, stalks and roots of the plant.
- "(11) 'Written documentation' means a statement signed by the attending
- 24 physician of a person diagnosed with a debilitating medical condition or
- 25 copies of the person's relevant medical records.
- "SECTION 2. ORS 475.340 is amended to read:
- 27 "475.340. Nothing in ORS 475.300 to 475.346 shall be construed to
- 28 [require]:
- "(1) Require a government medical assistance program or private health
- 30 insurer to reimburse a person for costs associated with the medical use of

1 marijuana; [or]

- "(2) Require an employer to accommodate the medical use of marijuana
- 3 [in any workplace.]; or
- 4 "(3) Preclude or restrict an employer from establishing or enforcing
- 5 a policy to achieve or maintain a drug-free workforce.".
